Advanced Manufacturing Expansion

What leadership teams should know before a project becomes urgent

Constraints form early

Expansion projects rarely become difficult on the day a site search begins. The decisive constraints usually started taking shape much earlier.

- **Workforce availability can narrow location options long before a project location is secured.**
- **Utility capacity and infrastructure lead times can become the real schedule.**
- **Site readiness and permitting can determine speed to market.**
- **Incentive eligibility often depends on actions taken before commitments are made.**
- **Early preparation preserves options and strengthens negotiating leverage.**

Five questions to answer early

1

Capacity

Where and when will the business need new production capacity?

2

Operating requirements

Which workforce, utility, logistics, and facility needs could constrain the decision?

3

Location options

Which markets can support the operation over the full investment horizon?

4

Project economics

Which incentives materially improve returns without creating excess compliance risk?

5

Decision readiness

What criteria must the project meet for management and board approval?

A practical readiness scan

READINESS AREA	LEADERSHIP QUESTION
Demand	What commercial or capacity signals could trigger expansion?
Workforce	Which occupations and skills will be hardest to secure?
Utilities	What power, gas, water, and wastewater loads are required?
Sites	Which facility or greenfield specifications are non-negotiable?
Incentives	What must occur before commitments or construction begin?
Governance	Who owns the decision, timeline, documentation, and risk?

Preserve strategic options before urgency takes over.
